### **ANZAC heritage and history of soft drinks win National Trust awards**

The ANZAC Memorial in Hyde Park has taken out one of the top awards in the 17<sup>th</sup> annual EnergyAustralia National Trust Heritage Awards, honouring the exceptional building and the principal war memorial in NSW. Showcasing the diversity of entries, a book recording the soft drink industry in Sydney was also honoured in the Awards presented today.
