National Trust Venue Hire | Lindesay
Darling Point

DESCRIPTION

Lindesay, at Darling Point, was built by the Colonial Treasurer Campbell Drummond Riddell in 1834, who purchased 17 acres reserved for him by the Acting Governor, Lieutenant Patrick Lindesay, his friend and fellow Scot, and after whom the house is presumably named.

Darling Point grew up around the grounds of Lindesay, which once swept down to the water. It was the first house to be built on Darling Point and attracted distinguished occupants. The house is the first domestic example of Gothic Revival in Australia, with fine interiors restored by the National Trust to represent the house of gentlemen, prominent in colonial society during the first half of the nineteenth century.

Lindesay is a much-sought after venue by brides, being an elegant 1830s mansion with full views across manicured lawns to Sydney harbour. In the pretty garden under the marquee you can have an elegant function for up to 100 people, or alternatively the music or dining room can seat up to 20 for small dinners. Only 12 large functions a year are currently allowed at Lindesay so book early to avoid disappointment.

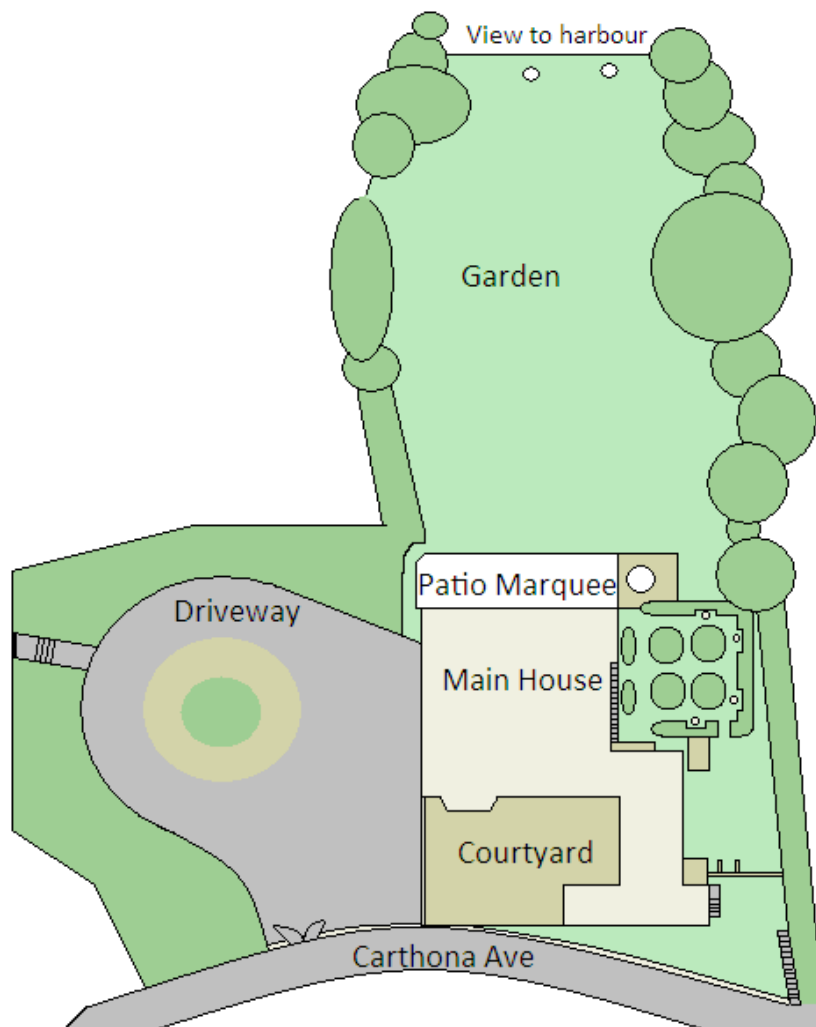

CATERING & EQUIPMENT HIRE

Hirers need to arrange their own catering through Lindesay's preferred caterers.

Lindesay provides a permanent marquee which is located on the patio, and the Dining Room includes antique table and chairs for 10 people. All other equipment is to be organised by the hirer, through Lindesay's preferred specialists. Please note, no amplified music is allowed on the premises.

BOOKING & PAYMENT

If you are interested in hiring Lindesay for your event, you will need to fill out a booking enquiry form and return it to the property. Alternatively, you can contact the property directly on the contact details below. The bond is required upon confirmation of booking, and the final balance is required at least one week before the event.

HOW TO GET THERE

Limited parking is available on site or on nearby Etham Avenue. Train: 2.5km or catch the 327 bus from Edgcliff station.

Entry to the property is via a gravel drive with ramp access for ground floor rooms and gardens, accessible by wheelchair. Access to the cellar and kitchen is by steep stairs, and not advisable. Access to the first floor is by narrow stairs with handrail.
